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Message from the Principal:

Dear Parents and Stakeholders,

Our 2017 School Profile is complete and ready for review. This profile gives a comprehensive view of our school's test scores as well as valuable demographic and community information. The Office of Educational Quality and Accountability (OEQA) has combined school and district reports into a newly redesigned 2017 School Profile.

Because the 2017 School Profile is for the 2016-2017 School Year, Bridge Creek Elementary is the school being profiled in the 2017 School Profile. In August of 2017, Bridge Creek Elementary became two new sites. The new sites are Bridge Creek Early Childhood Center (BCECC) serving grades PreK-2 and Bridge Intermediate School (BCIS) which serves grades 3-5. Next year, each of the new sites will have a separate 2018 School Profile.

The OEQA School Profile gives an overall picture of our school and community demographics as well as a breakdown of our students' performance on the state tests. Our students in grades K-3 are routinely assessed in the area of reading. Based on their reading assessments, they receive remediation as required by the Reading Sufficiency Act. Student performance in grades 3-5 is assessed through the Oklahoma School Testing Program. The State of Oklahoma adopted much higher performance standards in 2017. The test results are therefore not comparable to those from previous years. The 2017 test results serve as a benchmark and will be used to measure Student Growth as well as College and Career Readiness.

We are excited about the future of both Bridge Creek Early Childhood Center and Bridge Creek Intermediate School. We implemented a STEAM program this year and it was very successful. STEAM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math. We continue to strive for continuous improvement and have high expectations for student learning and achievement. Our school district has embarked on a creating a strategic plan for continuous improvement. Both BCECC and BCIS are excited to be part of the strategic plan. The plan has four goal areas which are Student Learning and Achievement, Quality Teachers and Staff, Culture and Community Engagement, and District Resources.

Thank you for your continued support and for trusting us to educate your children. Bridge Creek has a tradition of success and we look forward to continuing that tradition in all areas. Our community support is second to none. As we continue to grow and seek continuous improvement, our parents and stakeholders will play a large role in our success.
