As you know there has been a lot of turmoil in the area of education funding. This has prompted many districts, including our own, to make some decisions that are impacting the entire community. Some of these decisions although difficult will result in the same quality education delivered by Bridge Creek Public Schools. Two of the decisions made by the BC Board of Education were the conversion to the 4-day school week and staggering the start times of the schools. The new start times are now going to be:

BCES 8:30 a.m. to 4:10 p.m.

BCMS 7:30 a.m. to 3:10 p.m.

BCHS 7:30 a.m. to 3:10 p.m.

As a result in making this change, the bus routes, pick up times, and drop off times will be altered. As always we will set the drop off/ pick up locations in accordance with state guidelines. I know this will be an inconvenience, however please know we are taking all factors into consideration.

To eliminate congestion and confusion on back to school night, the transportation department will be available to start accepting calls on July 18 from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. with information on the new schedule. I encourage you to contact Bridge Creek Transportation at 405-387-3465, prior to back to school night to learn of your new transportation information. All routes will be impacted by this change. Please do not hesitate to call Christy at the bus barn.
