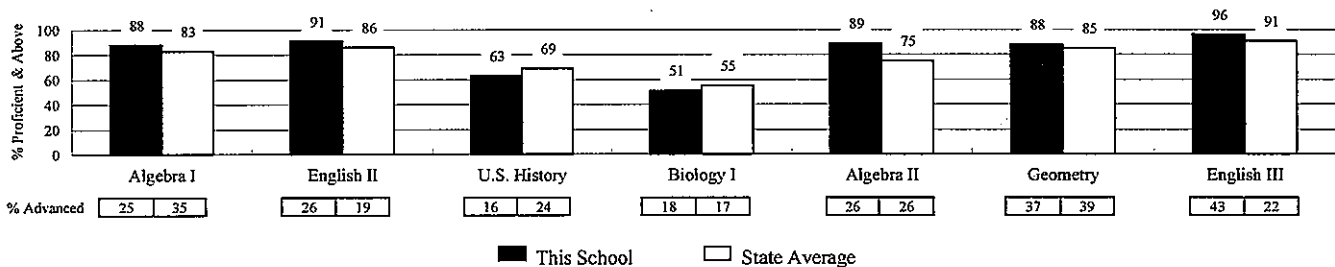

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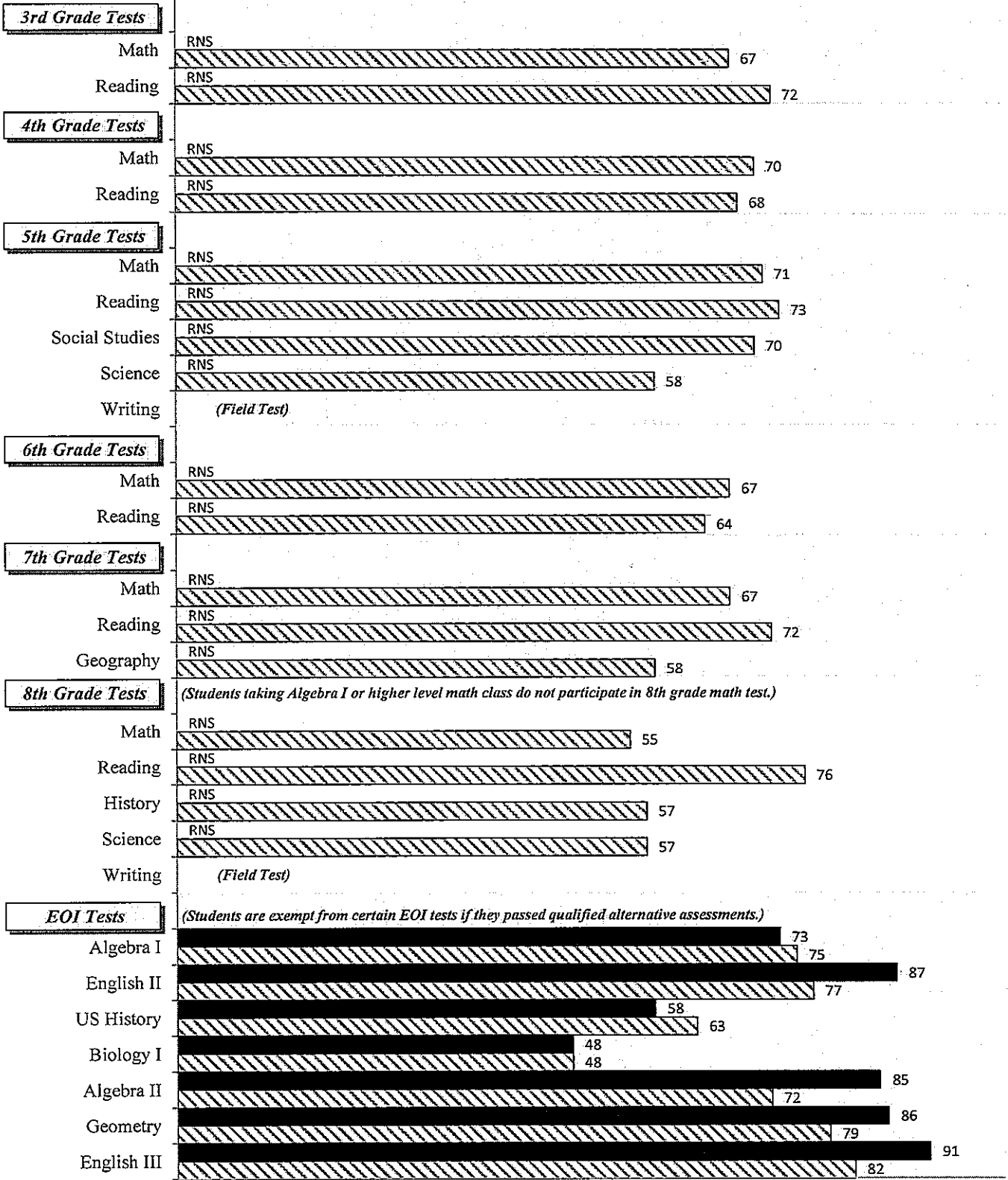
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**2015-16 Student Performance** (All Students, Full Academic Year)

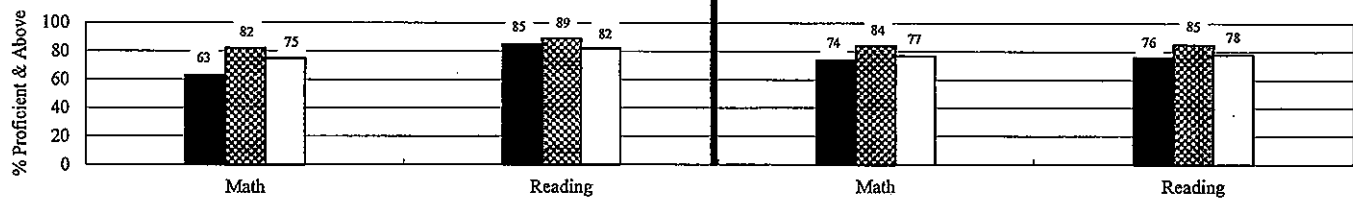

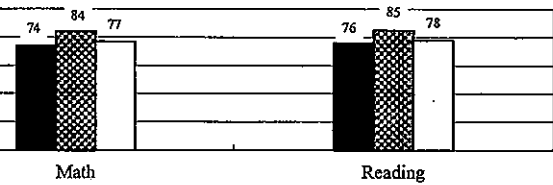

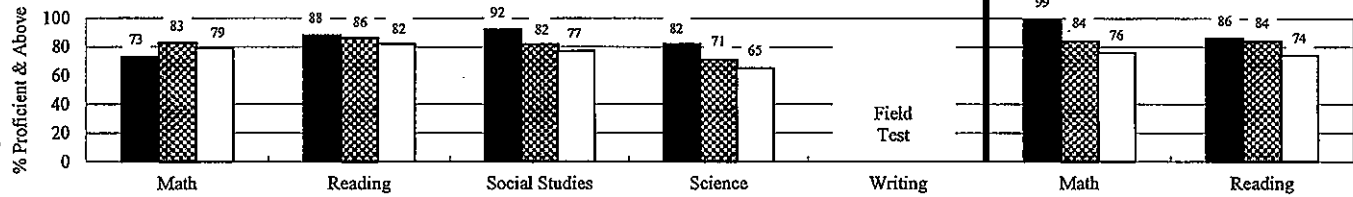
### 3rd Grade Tests\*



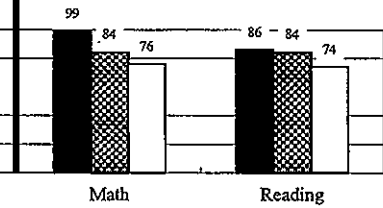
### 4th Grade Tests\*



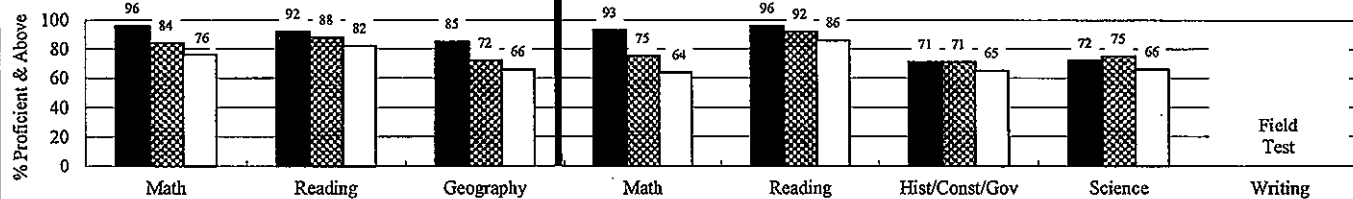
### 5th Grade Tests\*

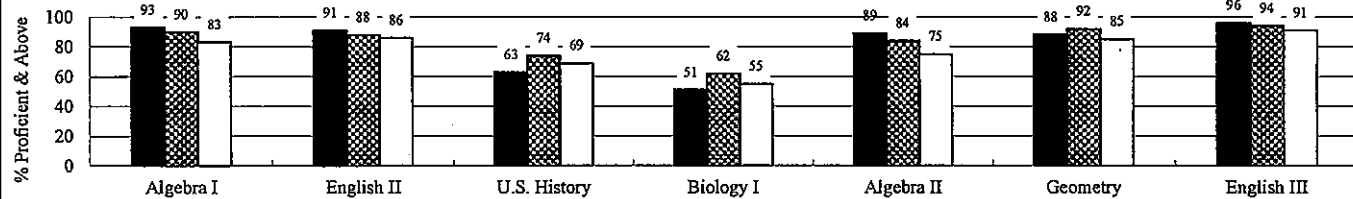
